- WHEREAS, the Idaho Sierra Club, Treasure Valley Clean Cities Coalition, and Idaho Power are working together to heighten awareness and accelerate the adoption and purchase of electric vehicles in Idaho; and
- WHEREAS, the City of Boise is dedicated to being a leader in the use of clean energy, establishing policies and programs that conserve energy, and promote sustainability, including the acquisition of charging stations for City fleet electric vehicles and for the public.
